Common Criteria for Information Technology Security Evaluation

Since 1998, there have been common criteria for information technology security evaluation, which are suited for the security evaluation of competitive products and suppliers, accepted as international standard, and very helpful for the security evaluation of IT products and systems.



The Common Criteria describe the scope of security-relevant evaluation, as well as the functional requirements in connection with threat and security targets, and the requirements regarding reliability.

Reliability

Evidence of outstanding quality and utmost security

Certification according to Common Criteria guidelines ensures that the VOICE.TRUST server meets the highest security requirements as well as particularly strict requirements in view of design, realization, documentation of security features, handling of security-relevant incidents, and test procedures.

Biometry

The Common Criteria certification is based on a close examination by an independent entity, in our case by the Federal Office for Information Security (BSI), and according to an agreement made between the USA, Canada, France, Germany, and Great Britain at the end of 1998, it is mutually accepted in the signatory states.
